Migrating to SAS®9: Impact and Opportunity

ABSTRACT

SAS®9 is truly the most significant software release in the 29-year history of SAS. Many customers migrate to the SAS®9 platform in order to leverage the new features that are available in various products, such as Web-based user interfaces, MS Office integration, SAS Management Console and Multi-Threaded procedures, to name just a few.

Whatever the reason for migrating, technical and business issues such as the following must be addressed to ensure a successful migration:

- * Compliance with existing FDA regulations (21 CFR Part 11, GxPs) and industry trends (data standards)
- * Methods for migrating existing data and code libraries
- * Impact on the SAS user community
- * Compatibility with previous versions of SAS

This presentation will provide guidance on how to address these issues, and ensure a smooth transition to SAS®9. We will highlight some of the differences between SAS®9 and earlier releases (6.12 and 8.2), as well as some of the features of SAS®9 that can bring increased value to our pharmaceutical customers.
